

students aged 16 or over who have completed high school education (Year 12 GCSE). We also offer courses at Level 2/GCSE as well as Level 3/A Levels, and Level 5/HND/ Foundation Degrees. Our full-time courses normally require students to attend class for approximately 18 hours per week.

A Levels (Level 3) Two years

This is a two year full-time programme with a minimum of three subjects studied and exams taken at the end of each year. On successful completion of all three AS subjects (first year) you

may progress to take the A2 course (second year) in the same subjects. Students achieving passes in two AS subjects may progress to A2 in those subjects as full-time students, providing they also take up an AS subject from a prescribed list. On successful completion students can apply to study a Bachelor Degree or other higher education course. Subjects include (subject to change): Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry,

Foundation Degree (Level 5) Two years These are valuable higher education qualifications which can lead to employment or a university degree. This is a two year full-time programme and students who successfully complete the foundation degree can apply to go to university for a topup course to complete their Bachelor Degree. Foundation Degrees offer an industrial work placement with a range of local employers. Subjects include: Accounting, Architectural Technology, Building Services, Events Management, Health & Leisure Studies, Hospitality & Tourism Management, Interactive

Entry Requirement: Students must have the equivalent of A Levels as well as the equivalent of GCSEs with at least a Grade C in Maths and three other subjects. Management. **Bachelor Degrees (Level 6)** BSc (Hons) Fashion Management. This is a three year, full-time programme, validated by Manchester Metropolitan University. Students will attend practical workshops and theory classes, with talks from visiting practitioners and visits to locally based enterprises in the fashion design, production, sourcing and retail sectors. There may be opportunities to display some of your

work publicly and attend fashion industry events.

Entry requirements: Students must have the equivalent of good 250 tariff points as well as a minimum of five GCSEs with a Grade C in Maths. Students should also have at least IELTS 6.0 (with at least 5.5 in each

element). Students may be asked for a portfolio or evidence of their interest in Fashion and/ or Art. International fees are £6300 per year (a discount may

be available for students with good IELTS scores).

BSc (Hons) in Social Work (Validated by Ulster University) (Level 6). This is a three year honours degree programme. Years one and two are studied at Belfast Met, whilst year three studies are undertaken at Ulster University.

Although the programme includes underpinning learning in the social sciences, such as social policy, psychology, sociology and law, the focus of the programme is on the development

of skills, values and knowledge required for practice.

Entry requirements: You must successfully complete a preparation for practice module prior to undertaking practice learning. You will undertake two practice placements - at Level 2 this will last for 85 days and at Level 3 it will last for 100 days. Applications to this course must be made through the UCAS system

using code L505. GCSE pass in English Language and Mathematics at Grade C or above. A Level: Minimum of 300 UCAS points to include BB.

ILC: A minimum of 300 UCAS points to include Grades BBBBB at
