	Management advised the Committee on the following key issues:
	 (a) Funding allocation is now known, and we have received COVID 19 Funding; (b) Forecasting cash breakeven and £8.5m deficit including non-cash items; (c) Uncertainty remains around student numbers; (d) Lecturers' settlement to end of 2021 has been approved and will be paid by end of March – the funding for this is within the core funding from DfE; (e) Key challenge remains funding for 2022/23;
	 (f) Non-Core income in 2021/22 is reduced, with traineeship numbers under budget and subject to clawback to DfE which has already been made; (g) Funding has been received and action is underway to deliver action in support of lost learning; (h) Staff costs are well below budget and there are considerable vacancies and, (i) Management will be able to achieve the 2021/22 budget but there will be challenges to meet the anticipated reduced budget in 2022/23.
	The Committee asked what the profile of staff vacancies was. Management advised that the reduction in enrolments is leading to reduced resourcing requirements, however, all posts that are required to deliver the curriculum to all current learners are filled, including across apprenticeships and traineeships.

Agenda Item **IHCFSA** Management advised the Committee on the following key issues: **HCEDSI** (a) On target to achieve budgets (b) Centre for Skills and Apprenticeships are on target with growth in the Public Sector Scheme and College Connect; and, (c) Main risk is around management of traineeships and Management are working to drive this forward. P&CE updated the Committee on recent sectoral/DfE meeting on policy direction, funding and delivery in relation to traineeships, that is, the wider implementation of the Traineeships curriculum. The Committee **noted** the action taken and the information provided by Management. The P&CE advised the Committee that: Management have done significant work to analyse the 2022/23 initial funding; the proposed settlement represents a significant cut to College finances; Management have made proposals to DfE on potential savings that may be made to close the gap between indicative funding and estimated expenditure, significant challenges remain and there will be further intensive negotiations across the sector; and. the funding issues will impact on the momentum of the range of economic and skills strategies that DfE are aiming to implement in partnership with FE Colleges. The Committee noted the communications received from DfE and the information provided by Management. RC36 21/22 College Strategic Financial Planning: Sustainable by Nature: Strategic Objective 5.4: **Delivering a Financially Sustainable College:** IDDD HOF (a) 3-year strategic financial planning & alignment to curriculum strategy (b) 1-year budget planning & alignment to business planning Management advised the Committee on the following key issues: (a) the strategic drivers for change which are informing the Colleges' long term financial sustainability; (b) Management is aligning the Whole of College 3-year Financial Framework with the Curriculum Refresh for the same period; (c) This work is engaging SLT on all aspects to manage the risk of funding cuts, the risk inefficiency and the risk of stretch forecasts; (d) The project will include robust challenge of zero-based budget proposals.
