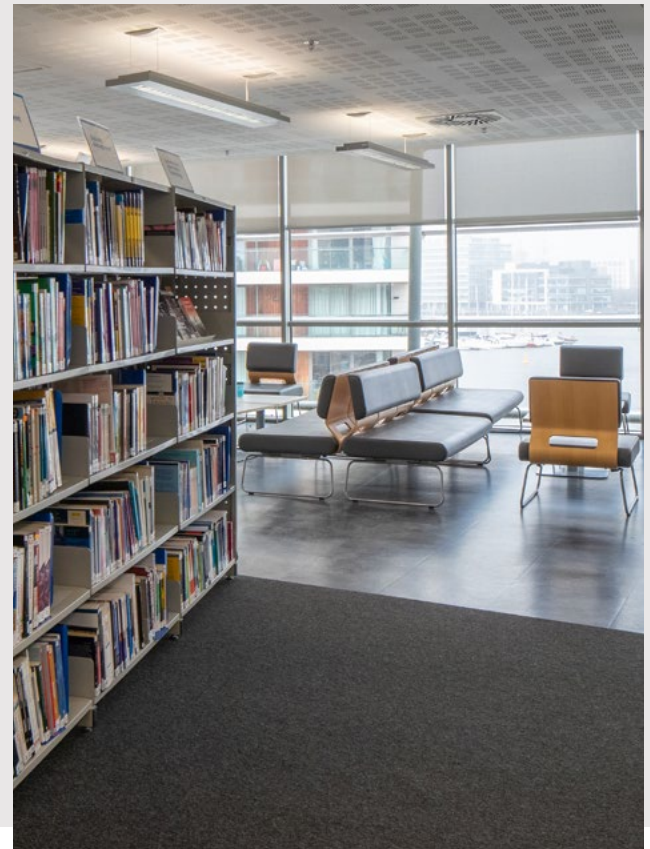
## Student Wellbeing

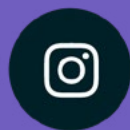
