Centre for Economic Development and Social Inclusion (CEDSI)

- Funding for Turing Scheme announced The College's International Office received funding from the newly launched UK Turing Scheme. The Turing Scheme replaces Erasmus+ and has enabled fifty Level 3 Business students to study for two weeks in the USA with Felician University, New Jersey.
- Futures Project The Futures project, delivered by Belfast Met, in partnership with Start360 and NI Housing Executive, has had an enormous positive impact on young people aged 14-24 since it was launched in 2018. Nearly 1,000 young people have been positively impacted by the EU funded project. 89% of Futures participants have progressed into employment, education, or training within three months of completing the programme.
- NI Chef Bootcamp Eight future chefs completed Belfast Met's first NI Chef Bootcamp. All participants are progressing into employment in our local hospitality industry. NI Chef Bootcamp is a collaboration between the six further education colleges of Northern Ireland and is funded by the Department for Economy under the Economic Recovery Action Plan (ERAP).
- Minister Poots visits Millfield campus to discuss green energy The Minister for Agriculture,
 Environment and Rural Affairs met with representatives from hydrogen-based technology project, GenComm, led
 by Belfast Met. The aim was to seek out the views and opinions of young people to help shape the success of the
 multi-decade Green Growth Strategy.
